

2015-2016 CMS PTO VOLUNTEER COMMITTEES

8TH Grade Recognition: Volunteers organizes the 8th Grade Recognition; including decorations, refreshments, raffles, activities (if any), chaperones, and clean up.

Battle of the Books: Volunteers help with invitations & refreshments for the party following the competition, as well as, certificates and trophies for participants.

Book Fair: Volunteers are needed to help with check-out and paperwork for Scholastic Book Fairs, held in the CMS Cafeteria twice each year (fall and spring.)

Budget Vote Poll: Volunteers are needed to work shifts for the West Genesee district budget vote, held at WG High School and make reminder calls to district families the day prior to vote.

Career Day: Volunteers are needed to assist our Guidance staff with this event by serving refreshments.

Dance Committee: Volunteers are needed to chaperone and sell/serve refreshments.

District Council: The CMS PTO provides two representatives to District Council, which meets 4-6 times each year. Reps meet with other PTO/PTA reps to share information and report back to CMS PTO.

High School Liaison: Representatives attend WGHS parent organization meetings and report to CMS.

PCIC: Parent Curriculum Information Council. Representative attends 5-6 meetings per year on various curriculum items and report back to PTO.

Scholarship Committee: Volunteers review scholarship submissions, complete a review form and help determine a winner from WG seniors who graduated from CMS.

Science Fair: Volunteers help direct participants to exhibit locations and serve refreshments.

SEPTSA: Special Education Parent Teacher Student Association. Attend meetings designed to help parents advocate for students with special needs.

Shared Decision Making: Attend meetings with team of teachers and parents to discuss educational and social issues, create agendas and proceed with actions. Meetings are typically once a month.

Spirit Wear: Volunteers coordinate student's spirit wear orders. Volunteer at Locker Night, Curriculum Night, and orientations to sell merchandise.

Staff Recognition Luncheon: Volunteers create invitations, decorate, prepare and serve food, and clean-up for the luncheon held in the Spring.
