

School Supply List – East Hill Fourth Grade

Welcome to fourth grade! We are excited about the upcoming school year. Here is a list of supplies to help your child have a well-organized and fun year. We look forward to meeting you and your child in the fall!

One Three Ring Binder or Trapper Keeper (**1 1/2 inch maximum**)

Eight Two Pocket Folders (**Please get heavy duty/glossy plastic folders** - they work best as they are sturdy and last all year.) Do **not** buy the type that has metal tangs for holding 3 hole punched paper)

Folder Colors – 1 blue, 1 green, 1 orange, 1 red, 1 purple, 1 yellow and one color/design of your choice.

#2 Pencils (plenty of them)

Large Package of Colored Pencils (buy a good set of the full-sized pencils - we use these a lot!)

Pencil Pouch (buy a large, heavy duty, cloth pouch that will last all year)

Erasers - 2 Magic Rub or any white type

One Dry Erase Marker (must purchase **low-odor** type with **THIN tip**, dark colors please)

3 Marbled Composition Notebooks (wide ruled only, at least 100 pages)

2 package of filler paper – 3 hole punched and wide ruled

1 packages of 3x5 white, lined index cards

1 box of tissues to share

1 Letter size clipboard
