<input type="checkbox"/>	<b>Box Tops for Education</b>	Parents collect General Mills Box Tops and send them to school. In the Spring of each year, all box tops are mailed to the company and a check is issued by General Mills for the total amount collected.
<input type="checkbox"/>	<b>District Council</b>	Parents act as liaisons between the WG District Council and Onondaga Road PTA. Liaisons attend WG District PTA/PTO meetings (about five per year) as well as general meetings of the Onondaga Road PTA to keep them informed.
