Dear Qualified Voter,

In accordance with the New York State Governor's Executive Order 202.26, the West Genesee Central School District previously sent you an absentee ballot for the 2020 annual meeting. It has come to our attention that the ballot inadvertently contained a typographical error. The original ballot transmitted to you inadvertently stated the budget was \$92,199.225 (Ninety-Two Thousand, One Hundred Ninety-Nine Dollars, Twenty-Two Cents).

**The correct budget for the 2020-2021 academic year is \$92,199,225: Ninety-Two Million, One Hundred Ninety-Nine Thousand, Two Hundred Twenty-Five Dollars.** This figure is consistent with what was presented at the Budget Hearing on May 27, 2020, and with the dollar amount on the budget statement.

In the abundance of caution, enclosed with this letter is a revised ballot, which corrects the above error. The remainder of the ballot is the same.

In the event you have not yet transmitted your ballot to the District, please use the enclosed ballot in place of the original ballot.

If you have transmitted your ballot to the District, and you voted on the budget based on an understanding that it was \$92,199,255 (Ninety-Two Million, One Hundred Ninety-Nine Thousand, Two Hundred Twenty-Five Dollars) there is no further action to be taken. Your original ballot will be counted.

If you have transmitted your ballot to the District, and you voted on the budget based on an understanding that it was \$92,199.225 (Ninety-Two Thousand, One Hundred Ninety-Nine Dollars, Twenty-Two Cents) please contact District Clerk Paul Pelton at 315-487-4563 or [2020budgetvote@westgenesee.org](mailto:2020budgetvote@westgenesee.org). The District will make arrangements with you to properly collect a revised, anonymous ballot and to set aside your previously transmitted ballot.

Please be assured that the District has developed control procedures so each qualified voter may only vote once; no duplicate votes will be counted.
