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Attendance Information

All Courses will have a variety of synchronous and asynchronous activities. Students will connect virtually with their teacher and classmates each day during their scheduled block. Attendance will be taken during the online meetings and there will be a daily attendance assignment that must be completed to receive credit for the course. These assignments must be done daily to receive credit for the course.

Students who miss more than three (3) classroom meetings and/or three (3) daily attendance assignments will be more than three (3) school days will be dismissed from summer school

Course Times:

Students assigned to Block 1 will log into their Google Classroom Meet at 9:00 AM.

Students assigned to Block 2 will log into their Google Classroom Meet at 10:30 AM.

Summer School Schedules will be mailed on Friday, July 3rd. Online access information and Google Classroom codes will be provided to each student by noon on Tuesday, July 7th.

Students who take the Participation in Government course are required to:

- Complete 5 hours of community service
- Attend one government meeting. Due to the current Covid-19 pandemic attendance can be done virtually.

- Students **MUST** register with their home school counselor ; OCM BOCES **IS NOT ABLE** to register students
- Registration for courses ends on Thursday, June 25th @ 12:00 noon.
- There are **NO LATE REGISTRATIONS**
- Schedules will be available online Friday, July 3rd.
